ROY D. MERRITT FOR U. S. PRESIDENT CAMPAIGN SPEECH # 50

- Hello, I'm Roy Merritt and I am running as a candidate for the presidency of the U. S. A. in 2024
- I'd like to again say "hello" to the people—good American citizens—of the U. S. A., including all those States where I have lived and worked for years each during my lifetime: my current home State and State of residence N. M., where I have lived twice (from 1988-96 and from 2020-present), also, NY, KY, AK, NH, WV, MN, WY, TX, and IN.
- This speech, Campaign Speech # 50, represents an important milestone in my campaign for the presidency and my chance hopefully to bring all of my prior 49 speeches into greater focus and clarity. And so, "here I go again"
- The Democratic Party Hispanic revolutionaries, terrorists, traitors and *coup d'étatists* had many, many pre-formed goals and objectives with regard to my retirement and beginning of my second term and tenure living here in "Terror Valley" of south-central New Mexico:

(<u>Goal 04</u>) Force me to have to work intensively in order to maintain our land and property. This was facilitated and ultimately accomplished by destroying two large areas of our land—lower and upper "park plaza" areas—prior to our assumption of the property

(<u>Goal 05</u>) Keep me on the "go" fixing and repairing things as a result of their acts of vandalism and terrorism so that our property could never have a finished look

(<u>Goal 06</u>) Create an environment, situation and circumstance where I could not entertain and enjoy all of my hobbies, avocations and amusements in life

(<u>Goal 07</u>) Denigrate all of my ideas, creative projects and entrepreneurism as being out of the mainstream. Maintaining that my xeriscaping and artistic structures, et cetera, were not compatible with the Southwest and living here

(<u>Goal 08</u>) Make certain that I came to dislike living here and hating our home and property. They didn't want me living here—in this house and on this property, long-term at least, from the start

(<u>Goal 09</u>) Destroying my sanity and peace of mind. Make me appear distrustful and "paranoiac" of the people here. They told me from the start, "there's no one doing anything TO YOU!" I thought this was odd and suspicious, as I had just got here. But they knew that years of terrorist acts were to follow in order to try to drive me and my wife out of the community

(<u>Goal 10</u>) Destroy everything "good" that we loved about America and liked about living here: our flag; our freedoms, rights and protections guaranteed by the U. S. Constitution

(<u>Goal 11</u>) Destroy our pride in America, including civic mindedness—not polluting and trashing our own environment and living spaces—in opposition to their desire and need for "property trashing" and "environmental terrorism"

(<u>Goal 12</u>) Denying me—"us"—my spouse and myself—the protections of American law and order, and the refusal of law enforcement to protect and defend our family and our property

(<u>Goal 13</u>) Destroy our happiness and our feelings of peace, satisfaction, and contentment. Take away any possibilities for a successful, fulfilling and happy retirement

(<u>Goal 14</u>) Destroy our "individuality"—the ability to be ourselves, do things the way we wanted to do them, and live the way we want. An example would be how we landscaped and developed our property and did improvements to our land, or NOT

(<u>Goal 15</u>) Negate our free movement and ability to move around, leave our home and property, and to go on retreats and mini-vacations

(Goal 16) Deny our ability to form associations at all in the community, and our ability to have friendships and general acceptance for who we were

(Goal 17) Destroy my reputation and slander me if possible

(Goal 18) Working to turn me against my own university whether I wanted to "turn on it" or not

(Goal 19) Destroy my health and well being

(<u>Goal 20</u>) Make us as miserable as possible and make living here difficult, uncomfortable, and prohibitively expensive. Use overcharging, surcharging, fleecing, scamming, swindling, extortion and bribery as economic weapons, and confusing these to appear as part of the American "free enterprise" system

- All of these main goals came together in the recent "Thanksgiving-Christmas" repaving project of Dripping Springs Road or "Dripping Trash Road," as I have come to refer to it. This project aided the ultimate goals of the Democratic Party Hispanic revolutionaries, terrorists, traitors and coup d'étatists in many ways:
 - (01) Slowing, hindering, stopping and interfering with my presidential campaign
 - (02) Further isolating me (and "us"—my spouse and myself) in my own house and on my property, preventing me from working outside and doing the avocations that I love to do
 - (03) Creating new vulnerabilities, anxieties and worries for me in my abilities to stop the trespassing, vandalism and property destruction, tearing down the protective County fence barrier in at least two locations,

allowing opportunities for invaders and intruders to enter our property, and possibly our house and home, unhindered to cause damage and destruction

- (04) Denying us the ability to enjoy Christmas as a respite from the "wicked world" of "Terror Valley," Las Cruces and Doña Ana County
- In this season of giving, it is also easy to recognize that the Democratic Party Hispanic revolutionaries, terrorists, traitors and *coup d' étatists* <u>ALSO</u> wanted to destroy CHRISTMAS, and for that matter, all of the other special holidays and traditions of America
- By destroying Christmas, they could ultimately destroy everything "good" about America and Americans—our kindness, generosity, amity, goodwill, tolerance and acceptance, and our "giving" nature and spirit—in opposition to their selfishness, envy and jealousy, parsimoniousness, and "taking, taking, taking" attitudes, nature and upbringing

 - -evil continues to reign supreme
 - -reward the most selfish people in the world
 - —make unable to relax and enjoy a break from the routine of the long year and regular day-to-day schedule of tasks



- —increase fear and fright
- increase concerns about, and decrease feelings of, safety and security in our homes
- -increase feelings of lack of success and having more failures in life
- —detract from spirit of "togetherness"
- —decrease "giving" spirit
- —more "taking, taking, taking"—robbing, destroying, tearing down, etc.
- —continue conspiring to do evil deeds
- -put under constant feeling of vulnerability
- —continue attacks on the vulnerable and weak—blind, crippled, disabled, aged, retired, et cetera
- -increase disrespect for elderly
- -increased use of threats, warnings, and coercion
- —more jealousy and envy
- -less caring, guarding, protecting
- —filling days and nights with more terror—more attacks, ambushes, raids, etc.
- -increase sadness, sorrow and loneliness
- —fewer acts of kindness; more acts of cruelty
- -lack of friendship and heartfelt greetings
- —creating more difficulties for people and making life hard
- —more disturbances of the peace
- -aggravating with mischief and mischief crimes
- —continual conniving and conspiring
- —pillaging, plundering and ransacking
