


ROY D. MERRITT FOR U. S. PRESIDENT
CAMPAIGN SPEECH # 56

- Good morning, my fellow Americans. I am Roy Merritt and I am running as a candidate for President of the U. S. A. in 2024
- This is Campaign Speech # 56
- The muted “war” here in southern New Mexico continues. The conspiracy continues. The treason continues. The terror continues, and the torture continues
- In addition to terrorists, traitors, and torturers, it appears that we also have saboteurs in our midst
- These saboteurs are working day and night, maliciously conspiring to disrupt and disable, undermine and invalidate my campaign, and also ultimately trying to destroy me as a person
- I have recently noted that someone has been vandalizing and altering my speeches by changing certain critical words and phrases
- I initially noticed this type of apparent sabotage several years ago when I was completing final editing of my autobiography. At that time, I spoke of it as “rats in my computer”
- I would make corrections, and then the next time I read through it, there would be other seemingly slight, but nevertheless, devastating changes in text that totally altered the meaning and effect
- Also, and relatedly, and considering myself somewhat of a poet, I have noted the dramatic effect of changing or altering one word in a poem. It can completely destroy its’ meaning and affect

- I now suspect that any and all of my campaign materials are, and have been, subject to sabotage, which means, of course, that my opponents are afraid of the message I'm conveying, and that is contained in my speeches, political poems, campaign books and other political publications
 - Thus, I wanted to warn you—the American people—about this in case you suspect sabotage when you are reading one of my speeches or other documents. Watch out and take note
 - As with terrorism, if you suspect sabotage, and see something in one of my speeches, particularly, that doesn't look or sound right, it is likely not. It has been changed or altered by a saboteur. Thus, you should say something, and tell others
 - By the way, as examples of this, from two of my recent speeches, the U. S. Constitution "*secures*" the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity. It does not indicate that we are charged with "*sharing*" our blessings with others, especially infidels and vermin
 - Furthermore, in a second misstatement, it is the "Grand Conspiracy" that continues and NOT the "Grand Symphony"
