## ROY D. MERRITT FOR U. S. PRESIDENT CAMPAIGN SPEECH # 19

- I'm Roy Merritt and I'm running for President of the United States in 2024.
- I'd like to say "hello" again to all of the people of the States pf the U. S. A. where I have lived and worked over the years: NY, TX, MN, IN, KY, WV, WY, AK, NH, and NM twice 30 years apart (1990-96) and (2020-present).
- I want to thank everyone across the U. S. A. and the world for their kind greetings and warm sentiments. Examples of these messages are:
  - (01) "Oh, no!"
  - (02) "Not you..."
  - (03)"It can't be!"
  - (04) "Look both ways before crossing the road."
  - (05) "No, thanks!"
  - (06) "Heaven, help us all...!"
  - (07) "You go, boy...!"
  - (08) "Remember to always check your fly!"
  - (09) "Watch out for all those cracks in the floors and walls of the White House!"
  - (10) "Forget it..."
  - (11) "Never mind..."
  - (12) "Your little dog is so damn cute!"
- In my early teen years, the mid-1960's or so, when one of my favorite singers of all time—Elvis Presley—left a concert hall after a performance, the announcer would let the crowd know that they could begin exiting with the following announcement: "Elvis has left the building."
- I have somewhat analogous news for all of the people of the U. S. A. and the world.
- I am sorry to report to you that my home State and State of residence—New Mexico—has now left the Union

- Residents of the State are no longer living under and following the U. S. Constitution, and no laws are being implemented across the State
- New Mexico is sadly a State of terror, chaos and anarchy!
- New Mexico's secession from the other States of the U. S. A. is an unstated *fait* accompli, a French term literally meaning "an accomplished fact"
- A *fait accompli* is a thing that is already done, so that opposition or argument is useless
- New Mexico has accomplished a silent secession—a withdrawal and removal of itself from other States without formal notification
- In fact, I believe that N. M. is the only State that has accomplished a full revolutionary secession from the Union of American States without firing a shot
- N. M. has gone its own way, and has broken off its Constitutional connections and disaffiliated itself with other States
- The only questions that I have in my mind are: Is N. M. the only one? And, can the State's secession occur without a War of Secession or Civil War II?
- In America's first Civil War, or War of Secession, soon after the Southern States seceded from the Union, the Civil War broke out
- We, as a nation, need to determine if there are other States that have silently seceded from the U. S. A. and its Constitution
- The election of 2024 would be the time to do this
- In any event, I believe that we, in the U. S. A., all have to live together one set of rules—that is, the Constitution of the U. S. A.
- We cannot have some States living under the Constitution and some not
- We cannot have States divided against themselves internally like N. M. is
- You cannot have States in which half of the citizenry are revolutionaries and terrorists to their own nation, and half are loyal, faithful, patriotic, good citizens

- From my perspective, after some 30 years away from my initial residency in the State, I see that many of you in New Mexico are in active rebellion against your own country, government, Constitution, and society in every way possible
- We, as American citizens, cannot live in fear, terror, chaos and rebellion
- We have to live with law and order and a disciplined society
- It seems that many New Mexicans do not want to obey the laws of the U. S. A. However, I believe that you were sworn to do that when you became citizens
- New Mexican citizens have indicated to me in more ways than one that their Constitutional rights, freedoms, and protections are not important to them
- For example, you don't seem to believe in free speech for everyone
- You don't seem to believe in freedom of religion, at least for everyone and all religions
- It is difficult for many Hispanics who are preferentially Spanish speakers to participate in freedom of the press and publication by making your ideas, thoughts and views known in the public arena in written or spoken English
- It does seem that you believe in freedom of association, at least to the extent that you do not want to associate or integrate closely with Anglos
- •You want to live the way you want to live
- However, many of you, I believe are selfish, as I have said many times before
- You want special rights and privileges that other citizens do not have
- You want all the "goodies" of the U. S. A., but you don't want to put in the full effort, time, work, sweat, and tears needed to obtain them
- You want to speak Spanish preferentially, have free or heavily discounted educations, especially at the collegiate level, and free medical care, preferences in employment and affirmative action that discriminates against many pre-exiting citizens of the U. S. A.
- You want to have as many children as you want while the rest of us are having one or two, or none, and while you're having all of these dependents, you want American society to pay for or heavily subsidize their care
